September 11, 2014 – Marc van Oudheusden meets the staff of CIDT to discuss the need for a Project Initiation Document (PID) for the upgrade of all websites with CIDT staff. Marc made a mind-map following the brainstorming session with staff.

CIDT has not been able to make a start with newsclippings until the course Marc van Oudheusden provided on October 30 – November 4, 2014.

AWF shares in CIDT

The board agreed in 2013 to obtain 40% of the shares of CIDT Limited Liability Company but was informed in 2014 that Egyptian regulations made this impossible.

Digital Investigation

Digital Investigation, a Dutch company with great experience in dealing with internet crime, completed their report on April 1, 2014, documenting their findings. The report pointed to Egyptian IT developer Hosam Abdel Kader as the perpetrator of the crime of sabotaging all websites and database on June 27, 2013. A case was filed at the Dutch police.

Board decision to request financial support to upgrade all our websites

On April 9, 2014, the board asked Marc van Oudheusden to assist CIDT in upgrading all websites. Misereor was contacted and agreed to financially assist in this project.
